 - How do you combat those fears? What would help you/as helped you overcome these?
 - How comforting is it to know the gospel is still effective and powerful today as it was then?
- 3. There are hostile forces at hand who are angry and displeased by our efforts of spreading the gospel.
 - Why is it that we easily allow conflict to distract and/or discourage us in fulfilling our purpose concerning the mission?
 - Where can we look for encouragement as we continue forward with boldness, especially in the face of adversity?
- 4. We need the gospel to be at the center of every aspect of our lives.
 - Why is that? And in which areas of your life do you need more of Jesus, today?
 - Pray, as a Life Group, that God would give you opportunities to share and live out the gospel and pray together for someone(s) who doesn't know Jesus.
